Patsy McArthur is a Scottish artist who explores the grace and power of movement through her naturalistic drawings and paintings. She studied painting in Aberdeen in the northeast of Scotland at Gray's School of Art, where, on graduation, she was awarded the prestigious Royal Scottish Academy John Kinross Scholarship to live and work in Florence. In 2001, she gained a Masters in European Fine Art from the Winchester School of Art Barcelona program in Spain.
